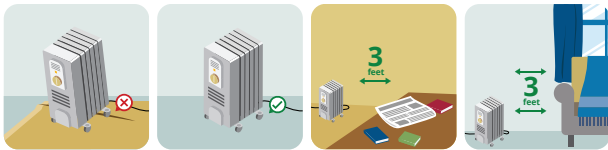


Heater Fire Safety

- ▶ Turn heaters off when you go to bed or leave the room.



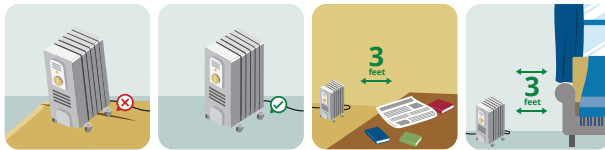
