## **2<sup>nd</sup> SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE MANCHESTER 2020-2021 ACTION PLAN**

The Town of Manchester is preparing a 2<sup>nd</sup> Substantial Amendment to the 2020-2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Action Plan to amend the allocation of the CARES Act funding. Manchester's CDBG-CV allocation under the CARES Act is \$812,580.

CDBG-CV funds must be utilized on activities that prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. The Town has successfully completed all activities proposed within the CDBG-CV Substantial Amendment approved by HUD on June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021.

Within the 2nd Substantial Amendment, the Town seeks to reduce the funds allocated to Planning and Administration from \$126,396.11 to \$48,396 and increase the funds allocated to Public Services from \$660,183.89 to \$734,216. The increased public service funds will support a Community Technology Program, designed to provide eligible Manchester households with access to education and technology.
