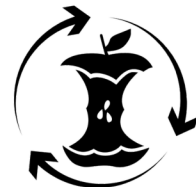




# Town of Manchester Food Scrap Drop-off Program

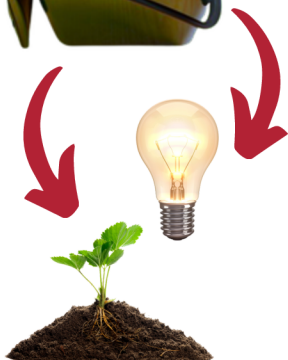
**1**

**Register for a FREE Recycling Permit** and check the appropriate box to participate.\* Participants will receive a FREE 6-gallon food scrap pail at the Sanitation Office! Already a current permit holder? Call or stop by the Sanitation Office to sign-up!



**2**

**Separate out your food scraps** by following the instructions on the back of this sheet. BPI Certified compostable bags and brown paper bags are okay to use. DO NOT use plastic bags.



**3**

**Bring your food scraps to the transfer station** where they will be collected and transported to a local facility for composting. The bio-gas that's created in the process will be captured for energy!



**All Manchester residents are eligible to drop-off their food scraps at the Transfer Station!**

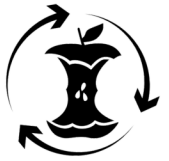

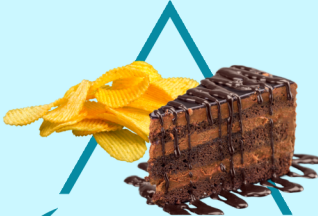
