Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)

Eligibility:

• Open to anyone 17 years of age or older to become certified in the State of Connecticut.

Description:

- The Certified Nurse Aide training program is a 120-hour course to prepare students with the entry-level skills needed to work as a CNA.
- Students will be required to complete clinical training hours at an area long term care facility.
- Upon successful completion of the program, students will be eligible to take the State Exam of Certified Nursing Assistant. Exam costs are included as part of the program.
