LEGAL NOTICE**

The second installment of taxes due on the Grand List of October 1, 2021, are due January 01, 2023. Failure to make payment renders the tax delinquent on February 02, 2023. Interest will be charged at the rate of 1 1/2% per month from the due date, January 1st. The minimum interest charge is \$2.00.

In compliance with Section 12-71b of the General Statutes, Motor Vehicle taxes due on the October 1, 2021 Supplemental Grand List are also due in full on January 01, 2023. These taxes are delinquent on February 02, 2023 and subject to the same interest.

FAILURE TO RECEIVE A TAX BILL SHALL NOT INVALIDATE THE TAX OR THE INTEREST CHARGES.

AVOID WAITING IN LONG LINES; MAKE YOUR PAYMENT BY MAIL OR ONLINE. If a receipt is desired, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope, and the entire bill. Tax Payments may also be made online at www.manchesterct.gov. A convenience fee applies for tax payments for real estate or personal property. Currently the convenience fees for motor vehicle tax payments are being waived until further notice.

The Office of the Collector of Revenue is located at 41 Center Street. Office hours are Monday through Friday 8:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. The office will be open until 6 P.M. on February 01, 2023. There is a drop box behind Town Hall available 24/7 for payments.
